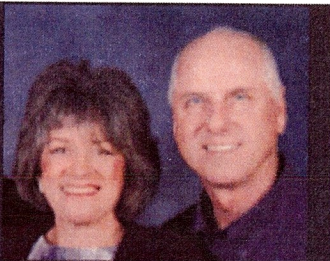

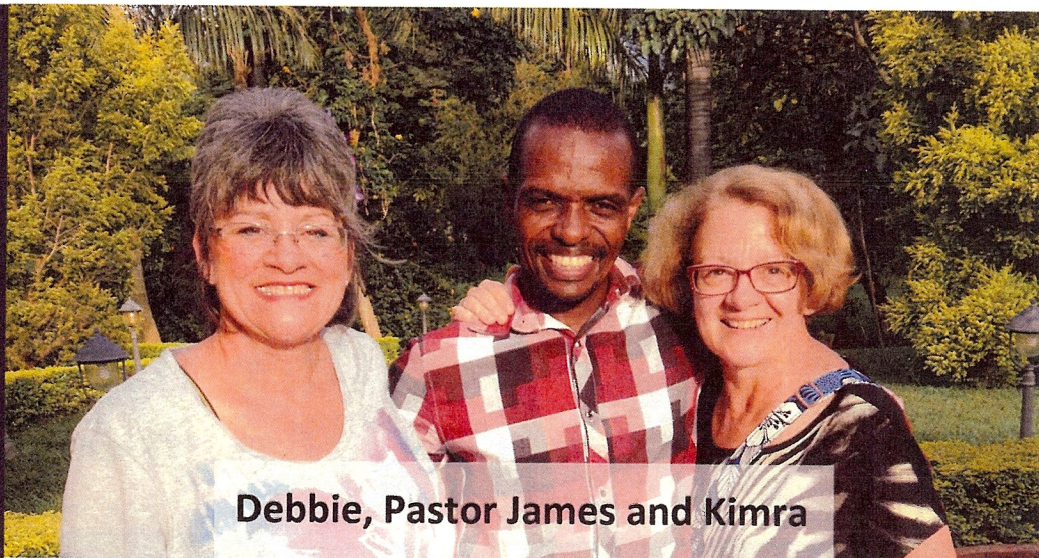

Alive After 7 Years In A Coma

For 15 long years James suffered greatly with severe stomach issues, and believe it or not, seven of those years he was in a coma. Our wonderful God brought him out of that coma and called him into the ministry. Here is 39 year old Pastor James Musasizi's amazing story:

"At the age of 15, I got a disease that my parents and I didn't know about which involved my intestines. When I was taken to hospital, the doctor told my parents that I will never live because all my intestines were rotten. They promised to do their best to help me. The next day I was taken to the theater (operating room) and all the doctors tried all they could the whole day but never got the results they wanted because the electricity went out and they used up all the gas.

They decided to leave me in the hands of God.

From that day onward, I went into a coma which lasted seven years. I was covered in many blankets and given lots of medicine through IVs. One day I came back to life but my belly was still rotten, so they had to take me back to the theater to fix it. Unfortunately the problem kept on reoccurring and they had to keep taking me back to the hospital for operations.

One day a U.S. medical team visited our village and were treating people for free. My parents welcomed them and shared with them what my condition was like.

God was with me! They were so touched that when they returned to the U.S. and they shared my story with other doctors, they decided to bring me to Richmond, Virginia for treatment! This took three months along with two more months to recover. Then I returned to Uganda and ever since I have never gotten sick again.

I studied electrical and computer engineering in Uganda and after Pastor John Wandera saw a calling upon my life, he sent me to the bible college in Tanzania for one year.

In 2009 he sent me to S. Africa for further Bible training. I spent three years there and came back to Mbale, Uganda to begin a ministry in a place that God showed me while in S. Africa. After all this, God gave me a calling that I have committed myself to fulfill—to serve Him and His people. May God bless you and keep you all and thank you for allowing me to share my life with you."

Pastor James is ministering in the most dangerous part of Mbale, Uganda to the drug addicts, prostitutes, witchdoctors, alcoholics and the like. 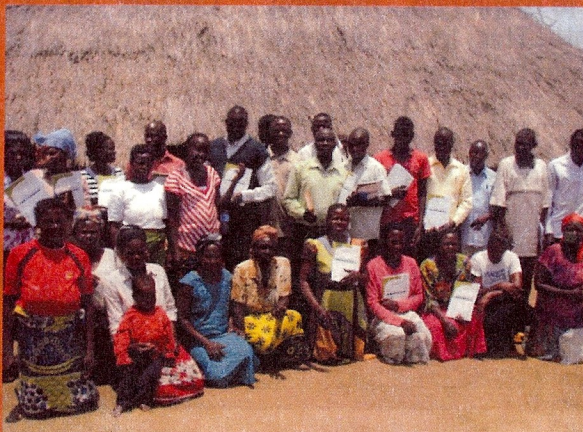
EXPANDING JOSHUA NATIONS BIBLE TRAINING SCHOOLS IN UGANDA

Pastor John and Jesca Wandera share their reports below as they traveled to Mbarara and West Nile, Uganda to introduce Joshua Nations Bible Training and start more schools. In Mbarara over 40 people attended the introduction of JNBTS training which was highly welcomed and received. We had representatives from four different regions to set up training centers in their villages. They thanked us for taking the Joshua Nation training centers to their regions which had never had training opportunities before.

On our way to West Nile, we visited a massive refugee camp. John Paul from Goma DRC and his family live here and minister. (Jack met John Paul in 2011 while in The Congo.) To our amazement, it's a huge camp with over 57,000 families from different countries in Africa: Rwanda, Burundi, Somalia, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Kenya, South Sudan and DRC.

We met with all the leaders there and shared about JNBTS centers which they whole heartedly welcomed. They are ready to establish our Bible Training Centers in their camps and since they have plenty of time, they requested for both 1st and 2nd year curriculums.

In West Nile, a pastor who traveled all the way from DRC has requested that we go establish this training in his area in May. This trip was very fruitful with lots of training centers being established. By the end of this year, over 30 training centers will have been established in Uganda!

The Lord answered the cry of my heart, and now I have been walking in a freedom that I never knew existed! Wow! If God is this good, I want more!!! You may not like the idea of being set free from a demon, but it's for freedom that Jesus came to set His children free! Deliverance ministry is for the church—it's the ministry of Jesus. The believer doesn't have to live under the influence of the devil any longer—Jesus is alive, and He came to set the captives free!"
