In Love with Africa

It was quite the ordeal to get at least seven shots, get visas and do all the paperwork and preparation and planning to leave the USA to go to the other side of the world. Then to fly for several days through five airports with four layovers (having two long flights being eight hours each), step ahead nine hours in time and finally, adjust to our busy schedule!

I struggled with getting sleep numerous nights. Just two nights I gently cried myself to sleep because of all I saw, felt, heard and encountered. With great excitement I personally discovered this truth to be real, "The joy of the Lord is my strength!"

It was such a glorious adventure to

be in two beautiful countries (Uganda and Kenya), within a huge continent where God is loved, worshipped and adored by the Christian community and where God is moving mightily with miracles among His beloved people of Africa!

The children were everywhere. There are 30 million people in Uganda with two million of them orphans ages 15 and under! Only 30% can afford school and only 1/3 have access to clean water. Believe it or not, 51% live on less than \$1 per day. There are only eight physicians per 100,000 people. Some of the children had never seen white people before. I frightened several babies during the graduation as I moved around to take pictures. They were quiet until they saw me. The children absolutely loved to dance for us and with us. Many women joined in as well. Men danced some but mostly they watched everyone else. The music was very LOUD and my ear plugs came in handy.

Oh what joy to discover that we had an instant kindred spirit with these humble, compassionate, kind,

wonderful, respectful, loving Christians in Africa. How we fell in love with them and of course, the many teens, adorable children and babies that we had the pleasure to meet! As I write this newsletter for us, I must confess that my heart is bubbling over at the thought of returning next year with another great team.

It would be awesome to have some medical staff come alongside and bring first aid items that we could leave with the villages so they would have access to them to bless their people. They have nothing and hospitals are many miles away and these people walk everywhere they go. Please pray and consider going with us next year. You will be blessed beyond your wildest imagination, refreshed, empowered and equipped with all the anointed teaching at the graduations and outdoor crusades! The Lord says, "Give, and it shall be given unto you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together and running over, will be poured into your lap. For with the measure you use, it will be measured to you."

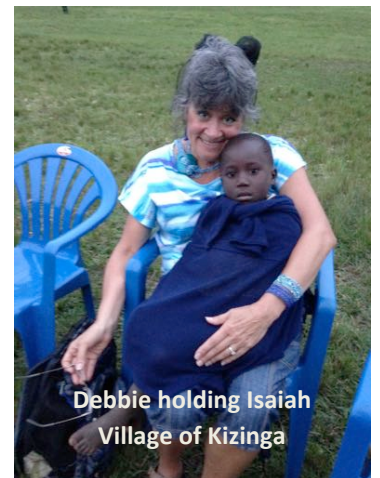
