I was honored to get to preach at a high school assembly in the Philippines. I was not scheduled to speak that day so it was a last minute surprise. This was a public school and the gymnasium was packed. I watched in awe as 1,500

students filled the room, knowing that God was using me that day to share with them about the Lord. Right before I was to speak, the Lord told me this was a reward for serving him in the prisons all those years, sharing with one person at a time. After I shared The Gospel, I would estimate about 20% of the students made decisions to accept Jesus Christ! What a thrill it was to my heart that many lives were changed that day.

Another highlight was meeting two

pastors in Dushanbe, Tajikistan, who were former Muslims. God supernaturally revealed Himself to them, and after accepting Christ the Al-Qaida had tried to kill them. However, God protected them in the most incredible ways I have ever heard! I was so humbled to get to minister at their churches and become their friends. These men are truly great heroes of our faith! They risked all they had including their very lives to transform this world with the love of Jesus.

Typhoon Destroys Philippine Bible College

When we were in the Philippines there seemed to be such an incredible outpouring of the Holy Spirit. At the time, we did not know that just a few weeks after our visit, a Typhoon would hit.

We conducted a Pastors' Conference at Zion Bible College in Tacloban. We also had the opportunity to have lunch and pray over the mayor who is a committed Christian. We then visited the island of Daram where we encouraged the believers there and baptized 32 new converts.

We conducted a two day Pastors' Conference where we fed, encouraged and equipped God's front line shepherds. Four new Bible Training Centers have opened in Mindanao with 145 new students enrolled. We helped dedicate a new church where I preached the following Sunday and many young people were healed of various afflictions.
