That’s just a little different than ministering primarily one on one in cell blocks which I have done over the past ten years! CAMAQUEY, CUBA

When I was in Cuba in January, I was approached by one of the pastors and told they had just received permission to begin ministering in the local jails and prisons. So on my second trip to Cuba this year, I was expecting to get to speak to a group of pastors about jail and prison ministry. I was disappointed on my arrival to hear that would not happen because of a variety of reasons. However, our four member ministry team ministered to and encouraged the leaders there who have been responsible for planting bible schools literally all over Cuba. I also preached and ministered every night at different churches around the city. I have really begun to enjoy ministering in small churches where the pastor is surprised that anyone from America would come to minister at his church. The ministry time every night was just awesome! I'd say about 90% of everyone I prayed for was healed and/or delivered. Praise to the Lord Jesus Christ! Glory to His mighty name!

On our last evening in Ecuador, a friend of mine who

accompanied me on the trip (Harold Severson) and I ministered in a small church in downtown Guayaquil. After the message a woman came up to us for prayer to be healed of a cancerous growth in her abdomen. When we began to pray for her, **beads of sweat immediately began forming on her forehead and neck.** Yes, it was warm there but not enough to cause what we saw! She also began to tremble and shake under the power of God and was instantly healed. Another man was healed and delivered of years of chronic back pain. It was fun watching him do things he couldn't do before we prayed for him.

I will always remember one boy whose father brought him up for prayer to be healed. He was around 8 or 9 years old and had some kind of bone disease and something else wrong with his throat.
